Learning Times Within the Class Group

From now on, **learning times will once again take place within the regular class groups**. This means that the children complete their learning times **together with their own class in their respective classrooms**. Learning times are **jointly supervised by OGS staff and the available teaching hours**. This close cooperation allows learning content, working methods, and expectations to be optimally coordinated, enabling targeted support for the children. We are also pleased to inform you that **learning time is now once again offered on Mondays**. As a result, learning times will take place on four days a week: **Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday, and Thursday**.

Shared Meals in Structured Settings

Lunch is a fixed and important part of our OGS daily routine. The children go to lunch in closed groups by grade level and are accompanied by their respective caregivers.

A Wide Range of Club Activities (AGs) and Projects

A special feature of our OGS is the diverse range of club activities. These are based on the children's interests and specifically promote their skills in various areas such as physical activity, creativity, music, social learning, relaxation, research, and experiences in nature.

Holiday Care – Reliable and Varied

We also offer reliable care during school holidays, tailored to the needs of children and families. Our holiday program is varied and gives children the opportunity to spend their school-free time in a meaningful and enjoyable way. Currently, we offer holiday care during the following periods: the first week of the autumn holidays, the first week of the Easter holidays, and the first three weeks of the summer holidays.
